

Yavapai-Apache Media Change Out and Piping Repair

Fann Environmental was contracted to change arsenic media and repair piping at Tunli for the Yavapai-Apache Tribe in Sedona. The project consisted of sampling the existing media, remove and replace spent media and support gravels, inspect interior of contractors and under drain manifolds, install new valves and piping for lead lag operation, install new valves at wellhead, backwash new media, disinfect system and bring system back into service.
